

Joseph V. DiTrollo, M.D.

Dr. Joseph Vincent DiTrollo was born on Christmas Day, 1950 and was raised in West Orange, New Jersey, graduating from West Orange High School in 1968, University of Richmond in 1972, and New Jersey Medical School in 1979. Urology training at New Jersey Medical School was completed in 1984.

He also attended the Universite' de Paris, Sorbonne 1972 – 1974. He worked for Vitreous State Laboratories in Washington, DC, under a NASA grant for the development and utilization of fiber optics.

He has been on the faculty of New Jersey Medical School since 1985, where he holds a full professorship in the Department of Surgery, a member of Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society, and has/is serving as the Chairman of the Department of Urology at St. Barnabas Medical Center, Hackensack UMC/Mountainside Hospital and the former St. Mary's Hospital in Orange, New Jersey.

Since 1979, he has been affiliated with the East Orange Veterans Administration and continues to support and service our veterans. His current position involves compensation and dispensation for nuclear, biological, and chemical warfare, as it relates to the urological system.

Since graduating medical school, he has been a member of the Alumni Association of New Jersey Medical School, where he served three terms as President and is currently the Chairman of the Board.

He holds numerous patents, and is involved in all aspects of technology and is a consultant for some of the largest companies in the urological field. His groundbreaking work on fiber optic technology led to the development of virtually all the current endoscopic equipment. He has presented over one-hundred papers and published numerous articles, nationally and internationally.

Holding both American and Italian citizenships, he is a senior member of the European Urological Association, as well as the American Urological Association.

He is married to his wife Joan for over forty years, has a son Justin and grandson Logan. He shares his interest in vintage automobiles and toy trains with his grandson. His father, the late Joseph DiTrollo, Jr. was Vice President, Division Director of Lionel Trains. His mother, Marie just celebrated her 98th Birthday. His only brother, Philip lives in Atlanta and is the owner and CEO of Georgia Expo, the largest producer of trade show equipment in the United States.
